JSI recognizes that forests, forest functions and forest products contribute to human well being worldwide and every country must value its forests and strive for equity in access to the benefits that forests provide. We believe that the timber industry has the responsibility to the people to base its commercial activities on properly managed and optimized forests.

It is the responsibility of our Purchasing Agents to follow our [Environmentally Preferable Purchasing Policy](#) and to secure wood specified in JSI products:

- From known, legal and well-managed sources.
- NOT containing endangered wood species listed in Appendix I or II of CITES.
- NOT plantation grown, unless there is a justified net social and environmental gain.
- NOT containing conflict wood.
- NOT from genetically modified trees.
- NOT from areas where traditional or civil rights are violated.
